I. Phase One – On the West side of the Jordan River

NUMBERS 20

1. Edom - fought against & refused Israel passage, forcing Israel to go around her territory

NUMBERS 21

- 2. Ammon King Sihon of Heshbon, leader of Amonites, resisted Israel & was destroyed JUDGES 3
- 3. Moab had also resisted Israel, subdued them for a time, then was defeated
- 4. Zaretan where the Jordan River waters parted & Israel entered into Caanan; Near Adam and not far from Jericho on the opposite bank

II. Phase Two – First battles on the East side of the Jordan River

JOSHUA 6

5. Jericho - destroyed

JOSHUA 7 & 8

6. Ai - destroyed

7. Bethel - taken

JOSHUA 9

8. Gibeon – treaty made with Israel

JOSHUA 10

9. the 5 Kings of the Amorites at Gibeon – Israel destroys the combined army of the Kings of Jerusalem, Hebron, Jarmuth, Lachish and Eglon

JUDGES 1

- 18. Debir conquered by Judah as part of her allotted domain
- 19. Hormah conquered by Judah as part of her allotted domain
- 20. Gaza conquered by Judah as part of her allotted domain
- 21. Ashkelon conquered by Judah as part of her allotted domain
- 22. Ekron conquered by Judah as part of her allotted domain

I SAMUEL 31

- 23. Mount Gilboa where King Saul and his sons died in battle against the Philistines II SAMUEL 5
- 24. Jerusalem King David at last captures Jerusalem from the Jebusites for Israel
