## A Prayer to Our Lady Undoer of Knots 1 by Pope Francis I 2

"Holy Mary, full of GOD's Presence, during Your life You accepted The Father's Will with full humility, and the devil was never able to tie You up with his confusion." *LUKE 1:38 - Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of The Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.*<sup>3</sup>

"Since then, You have interceded for all our difficulties, as You did at the wedding feast of Cana."

JOHN 2:5 - His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever He tells you."<sup>4</sup>

"Full of kindness and patience, You show us how to untie the knots of our lives. By always being our Mother, you arrange and clarify the ties that link us to The Lord."

**PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7 -** Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to GOD. Then The Peace of GOD that surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in CHRIST JESUS. <sup>5</sup>

**EPHESIANS 2:8** - For by Grace you have been saved through Faith, and this is not from you; it is The Gift of GOD;<sup>7</sup>

"Free from confusion and error, may we find Him in all things, keep our hearts in Him, and serve Him always in our brothers and sisters." Amen!

*MICAH* 6:8 - You have been told, O mortal, what is good, and what The LORD requires of you: Only to do justice and to love goodness, and to walk humbly with your GOD.<sup>8</sup>
