

At The Lamb's High Feast – Why WE Sing!

JOHN 15:9-11. Because...

⁹ As The Father hath loved Me, so have I loved you: continue ye in My Love.

¹⁰ If ye keep My Commandments, ye shall abide in My Love; even as I have kept My Father's Commandments, and abide in His Love.

¹¹ These Things have I spoken unto you, that My Joy might remain in you, and that your Joy might be full! ⁱ

PSALM 33:20-22. Therefore...

²⁰ Our soul waiteth for The LORD: he is our Help and our Shield.

²¹ For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His Holy Name.

²² Let Thy Mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in Thee! ⁱⁱ
