# The Joy of The LORD is Our Strength!

**I. PSALM 28:6-9** <sup>6</sup> Blessed be The LORD, because He hath heard the voice of my supplications. <sup>7</sup> The LORD is my strength and my shield:

my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped: therefore my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise Him.

<sup>8</sup> The LORD is their strength, and He is the saving strength of His Anointed. <sup>9</sup> Save Thy people, and bless Thine inheritance: feed them also, and lift them up for ever.<sup>1</sup>

# II. Where Do We Go for Our Strength and Joy?

Where do we go to find strength and joy? Is it possible to possess these things without GOD? It is in hearing the question daily, "What is the chief and highest end of man?" It is in confessing and living out the answer daily, "...to glorify GOD and fully to enjoy Him forever!"<sup>2</sup>
