"Those making these... [bioagents] have enough scientists to know that antibody priming will happen. We have to face to truth... Their intention is to exterminate humanity."

"As a Franciscan Friar, I have to tell you, you have to start preparing yourself spiritually for this. As Christians, we are obliged to test what is true and false, and hold only what is True..."

"We are living now like in the summer of 1914 before WWI, when no one knew tens of millions of people would die soon in a war." Possible that multitudes "in the world may die... As Christians, we have to step forward and fill the breach in the gaps... If you have not received the... [bioagent], you will be asked to help bury the dead.... a Work of Mercy."

Be prepared to comfort the dying and preach The saving Gospel of CHRIST, for in "the darkest age of humanity... The Truth is our greatest Defense and Ally... say The Rosary and pray to GOD daily, practice detachment to not judge the dying."

Calls for the healthy to protect themselves, remain calm, do not be surprised if Clergy abandon the Faithful and people abandon their dying loved ones. "...The people that have taken the... [bioagent] are dying from [bioagents] that you are immune to."

Possible "a lot will die of heart attacks, a lot of despair..." Prepare to help people "repent and die in a state of Grace."

The Works of Mercy are charitable actions by which we come to the aid of our neighbor in his spiritual and bodily necessities.  
[ISIAIH 58:6-7; HEBREWS 13:3]

Instructing, advising, consoling, comforting are spiritual Works of Mercy, as are forgiving and bearing wrongs patiently.

The corporal Works of Mercy consist especially in feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and imprisoned, and burying the dead.

Among all these, giving alms to the poor is one of the chief witnesses to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God:

3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into JESUS CHRIST were baptized into His Death?

4 Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as CHRIST was raised up from the dead by The Glory of The Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

5 For if we have been planted together in The Likeness of His Death, we shall be also in The Likeness of His Resurrection:

6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

7 For he that is dead is freed from sin.

8 Now if we be dead with CHRIST, we believe that we shall also live with Him:

9 Knowing that CHRIST being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over Him.

10 For in that He died, He died unto sin once: but in that He liveth, He liveth unto GOD.

11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto GOD through JESUS CHRIST our Lord.
