The Feast of Our Lady of The Rosary "...originated in 1571, when the [naval] Battle of Lepanto saw an invading [Turkish] muslim army defeated in [the Mediterannean Sea by] Greece, after Saint [Pope] Pius V called the faithful [throughout Christendom] to pray The Rosary for the protection of Europe."

Had The Holy League of Christian Europe lost the naval Battle of Lepanto in 1571, and had the Muslims armies not been defeated at the Battle of Vienna in 1683, all of the continent would likely have eventually been slaughtered and enslaved by the demonic hordes of muhammed.
