"Andrew was the first of the Apostles to find JESUS; he brought his brother Simon [Peter] to Him (JOHN 1:35-42). After Pentecost, he is said to have preached in Greece, where he died, bound to a Cross." Tradition teaches that "...This Cross [has] the shape of an "X" - suggesting that Andrew found himself unworthy to die on a Cross identical to that of our Lord.

The 6th Century "Passion of Saint Andrew" has the Apostle addressing the instrument of his Martyrdom: "I came to you confident and joyful, so that you too may receive me exultant as a disciple of The One Who was hung upon you. O blessed Cross, clothed in The Majesty and Beauty of The Lord's limbs!"

Saint Andrew showed his courage, not by physical prowess, but by his unrelenting commitment to The Gospel of The Cross written in The Blood of JESUS CHRIST. Andrew died as he had lived, the true servant of his beloved Master, Whose Message of Love and Mercy shaped Andrew's life and death." *

The Apostle Andrew is a Patron Saint of Scotland, as well as fishermen, singers, Romania, Russia, Ukraine and Patras, Greece. His "X" shaped cross is found in the flag of Scotland, the American Confederate battle flag and incorporated into the flag of the United Kingdom.

Saint Andrew, Apostle & Martyr, pray for us, that GOD would give us also The Grace needed to live and die as faithful servants of The Word of GOD, CHRIST our Saviour and His remnant faithful Church. Amen.

- 18 But I say, Have they not heard? "Yes verily, their sound went into all the earth, and their words unto the ends of the world." [PSALM 19:4]
