Devout Catholic, faithful wife, devoted mother of 8 children.

After 28 years of happy marriage her beloved husband died. Bridgette was an holy widow and became the foundress of the Order of the Most Holy Savior (the Bridgettines).

She became a reformer of monastic life, encourager of Popes to return to Rome from Avignon and a gifted mystic. Saint Bridgette was known for her Christian virtue, deep piety, strict poverty, assistance to the poor, devotion to The Virgin Mary, and many pilgrimages to shrines of The Saints.

She wrote of her intense, highly detailed, and provocative spiritual revelations of CHRIST's Words on death and judgment; Heaven and Hell; right versus wrong. Her writings spread throughout Europe, stirring the hearts and souls of The Faithful.

So profound was this good lady's effects throughout Christendom, that she was canonized as a Saint on 18 years after her death, in 1391. Saint Pope John Paul II declared Saint Bridget a co-patron of Europe in 1999. Good Saint Bridgette of Sweden, pray for us! Amen.
