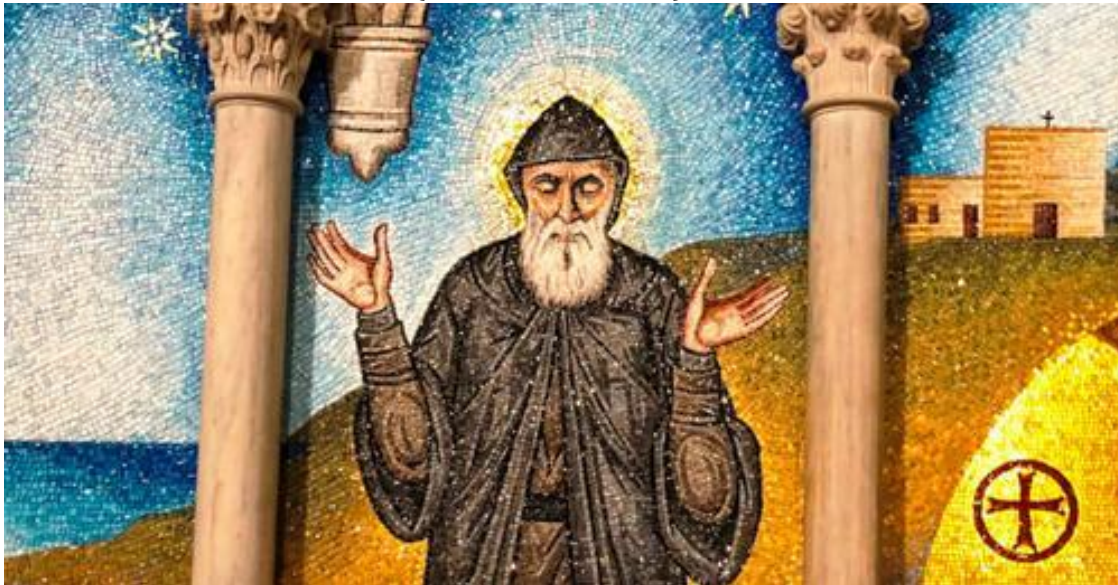


Saint Fr. Sharbel Makhlūf (1828 -1898 AD)
