

Saint John Chrysostom, Bishop & Doctor of The Church, the "Golden Mouthed Preacher" (344 - 407 AD)

"John Chrysostom, the "Golden-mouthed," was born at Antioch in Syria (present-day Turkey) in 349. He spent four years in a hermitage and was later ordained a Priest in Antioch, where he delivered his famous homilies "On the Statues" in the wake of violent civil demonstrations.

"We are commanded to have only one enemy the Devil," he taught. "With him never be reconciled! But with a brother, never be at enmity in your heart."

In 397, John was elected Bishop of Constantinople, the seat of the Byzantine Empire. His willingness to preach The Gospel "in season and out of season" (II TIMOTHY 4:2) resulted in his banishment to Armenia in 404. He died at Comana in 407. John is a patron [Saint] of Preachers." *
