"The daughter of the Saxon King Edmund the Exile, Margaret married King Malcolm III of Scotland around 1070. She bore him eight children. Margaret was an instrument of Grace in both her marriage and her nation.

She read aloud to her illiterate husband, encouraging in him a love of learning and a spirit of prayer. "Whatever she refused, he refused also," her biographer tells us, "whatever pleased her, he also loved for the love of her."

King and country followed the Queen in her Works of Mercy of the sick and the impoverished. Under Margaret the Churches were adorned with art, and Monastic life flourished." *
