"Rose Philippine Duschesne was born in France, and in 1804 entered the newly-founded Society of The Sacred Heart [of JESUS]."

The Order was founded in the terrible upheaval of post-Revolutionary France by Saint Mother Madeleine Sophie Barat to help call people back to The Lord and The Church. Their motto is "Cor Unum et Anima Una in Corde JESU" - "One Heart and One Soul in The Heart of JESUS."

Saint Rose, in 1818, with "...five Sisters of the Order, traveled to the [American] frontier town of Saint Charles, Missouri, and opened the first school for girls between the Mississippi River and the Rocky Mountains. The next twenty years were dedicated to founding schools.

Rose made her mission at the age of seventy-two among the Potawatomi Indians, where her infirmities kept her indoors. The Indians named her Quah-kah-ha-num-ad, "Woman-Who-Always-Prays."

After returning to the motherhouse, she slept in a little closet and spent long hours before The Blessed Sacrament. She died in 1852." \*
