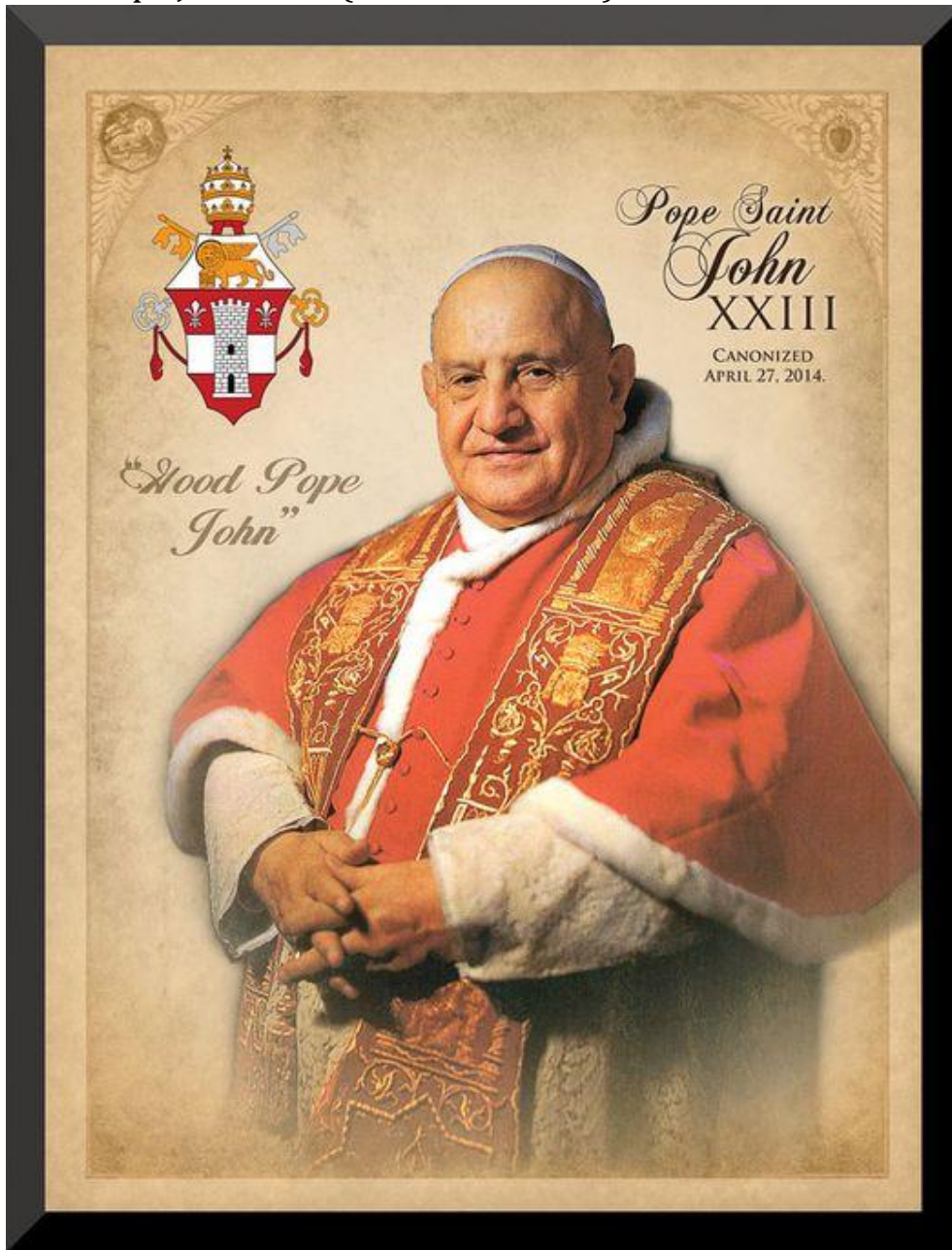


Saint Pope John XXIII (1881 - 1963 AD)

"Before he was elected Pope John XXIII in 1958, Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli had served as a military Chaplain and a Vatican diplomat in Bulgaria, Turkey and France. He had ministered to war-wounded soldiers and helped Jews fleeing the Nazis obtain transit visas" during WWII.

“Deeply caring for all he encountered in fervent Christian Charity, and

a well beloved Pontiff, he became known as 'Good Pope John.' "As Pope, he convened the 'Second Vatican Council' on October 11, 1962.

That evening, he told the gathered faithful, "When you head home, find your children. Hug and kiss your children and tell them, 'This is the hug and kiss of the Pope...' Give anyone who suffers a word of comfort. Tell them, 'The Pope is with us especially in our times of sadness and bitterness.'

He died in 1963," * not seeing the completion of the work - for better and for worse - of 'Vatican II.' Yes, The Holy Bible is now most vitally read in the vernacular tongues, so that the Faithful may better understand The precious Word of GOD. This great good is part of 'Good Pope John's' legacy.

But the 'Protestantization' of The Roman Catholic Church has brought with it also a dilution of the faithfulness and holiness before The Lord of That same Church ~ both Clergy and Laity ~ and an impingement upon The True Gospel of CHRIST by a worldly pseudo-gospel of leftist psychosocial politics championed by the current Roman Pontiff and much of his hierarchy. This, too, is part of Pope John XXIII's legacy.
