

"As a young girl in Avila, Spain, Teresa, inspired by the stories of the Saints, briefly ran away to "become a Martyr." Years later, she would counsel her Nuns to seek detachment from earthly things, that they might run straight to GOD.

With the aid of Saint John of The Cross, she reformed the Carmelite Order, advocating penance, silence and a simple habit without shoes, hence "discalced." Teresa died in 1582.

Her spiritual treatises earned her the title "Doctor of The Church" in 1970. "Let nothing disturb you, let nothing frighten you," she advised, "all things are passing away: GOD never changes. Patience obtains all things. Whoever has GOD lacks nothing; GOD alone suffices." *
