"Born in 1542 in Montepulciano in Tuscany [Italy], Robert entered the Jesuits and was assigned to the chair of apologetics at the Jesuit Roman college.

His... [knowledgeable] lectures on the defense of The Faith against the Reformation thinkers, published as "On The Controversies," were assumed by many to be the work of a team of Jesuit scholars.

In the century following its publication, over two hundred Protestant authors composed responses to it. Robert, in his writings, patiently laid out his opponents' arguments; in his prayer, he begged for their conversion.

He was canonized in 1930. A year later Pope Pius XI named Robert a Doctor of The Church, calling him the "Prince of Apologists."" *
