"Rose was born in Lima, Peru.. As a young girl, she read about Catherine of Siena, and became determined to imitate the great Saint. Like Catherine, she entered the Dominican Third Order and received profound Graces in prayer.

Rose wore a spiked silver crown disguised with roses and slept on a bed of broken tiles - mortifications she endured for the conversion of sinners and the native Peruvians.

After her death at the age of thirty-one, great crowds followed her funeral procession. Rose was canonized in 1671, the first Saint born in the New World."*
