
Servant of GOD Fr. Franz Reinisch, SAC, Martyr (1903 - 1942 AD)



- 22 And straightway JESUS constrained His disciples to get into a ship, and to go before Him unto the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.
- 23 And when He had sent the multitudes away, He went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, He was there alone.
- 24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary.
- 25 And in the fourth watch of the night JESUS went unto them, walking on the sea.
- 26 And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.
- 27 But straightway JESUS spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.
- 28 And Peter answered Him and said, Lord, if it be Thou, bid me come unto Thee on the water.
- 29 And He said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to JESUS.
- 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
- 31 And immediately JESUS stretched forth His hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?
- 32 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.
- 33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped Him, saying, Of a truth Thou art The Son of GOD.
