

"After an earlier attempt ailed, the Korean Church arose in the late 18th century after a Korean visitor heard CHRIST preached by the Jesuits in China, and brought Christian tracts home to share.

Persecutions began when the Korean authorities attacked the fledgling Christian community for introducing foreign influences into the country. Among the saints honored on this feast are eleven Priests and ninety-two Laypersons. These Martyrs were scholars, court officials, farmers, merchants, widows and wives.

Each had found the pearl of Great Price and gave his or her life for it. They represent the countless others who met death, rather than renounce their Faith during a hundred years of persecution." *

Today, although their brothers and sisters in North Korea continue to suffer horrific persecution of the darkest nature under a brutal communist dictatorship, South Korea has become one of the strongest Christian nations and senders of Evangelists in the world today.

The blood and suffering of the Saints has brought forth great fruit for The Kingdom of GOD on earth, and in Heaven.
